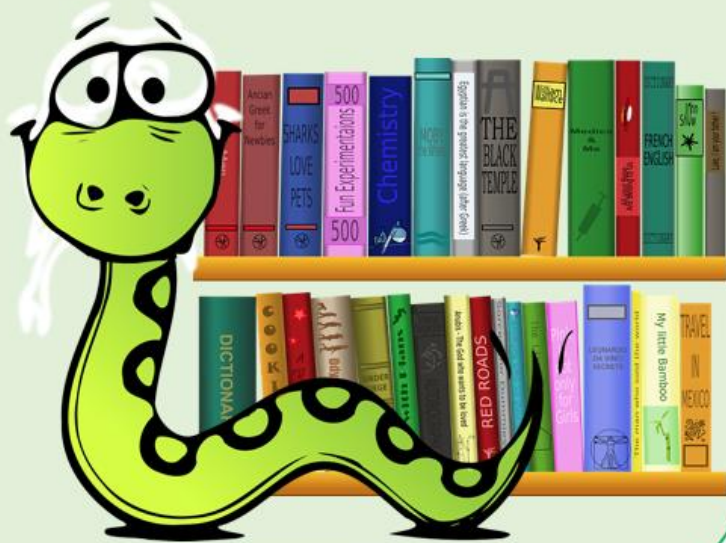

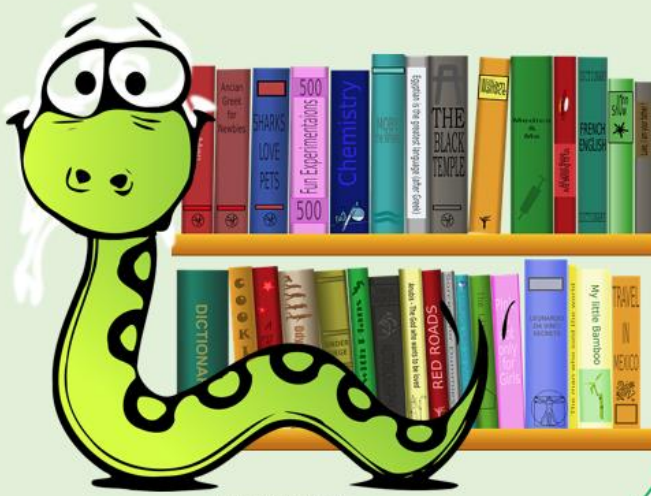

ABECEDARIAN

[ey-bee-see-dair-ree-uhn] . *noun*

An abecedarian is someone who is learning the alphabet or who is a beginner in any subject.



ABSQUATULATE

[uhb-skwoch-uh-leyt] . *verb*

When someone absquatulates, they leave a place very quickly and without warning. People use this word when they want to be funny.



AILUROPHILE

[ahy-lyoor-ruh-fahyl] . *noun*

An ailurophile is someone who loves cats.



ALIENATE

[ey-lee-uh-neyt] . *verb*

If you alienate someone, you make them feel sad and like they are all alone.

ALOOF

[uh-loof] . *adjective*

When someone is aloof, they are not very friendly or easy to talk to.

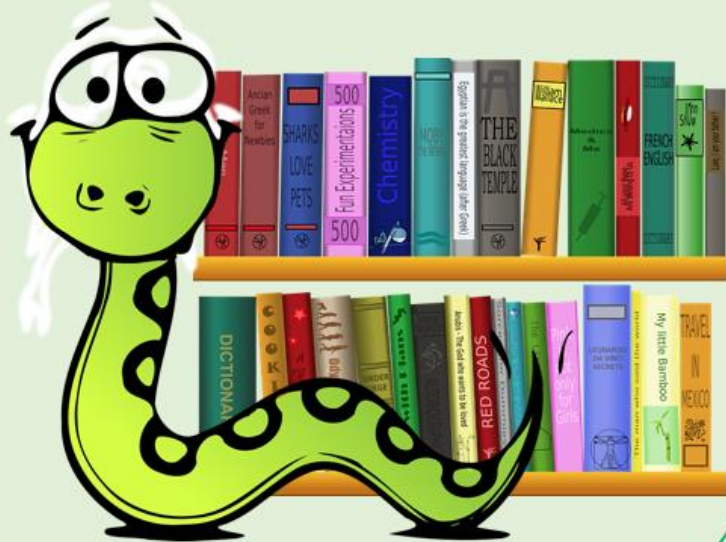

noun

a conclusion reached on the basis of evidence and reasoning.

"researchers are entrusted with drawing inferences from the data"

Similar:

deduction

conclusion

reasoning

conjecture

speculation

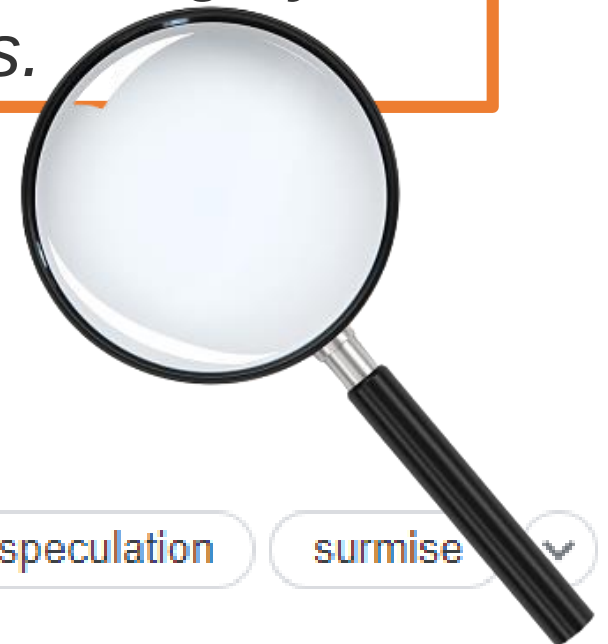

Infer

Make and justify inferences using evidence from the text.

Example: *Mary could see that her friend was nervous about speaking in front of the class **because** she was fidgeting in her seat and avoiding eye contact with other students.*

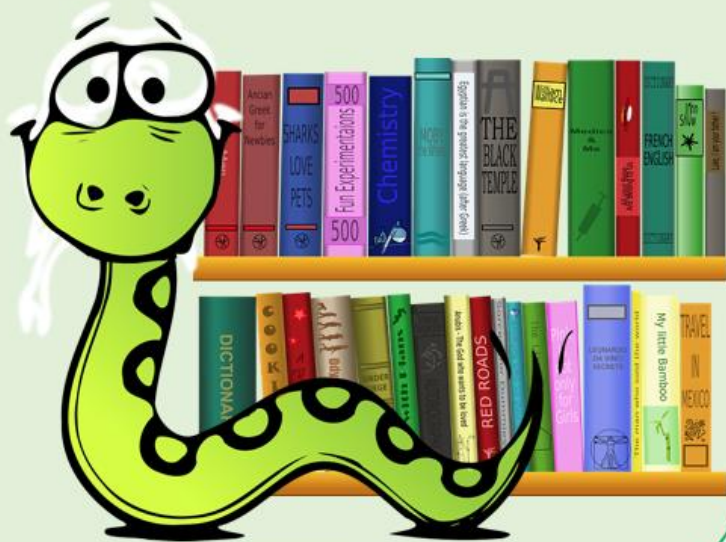
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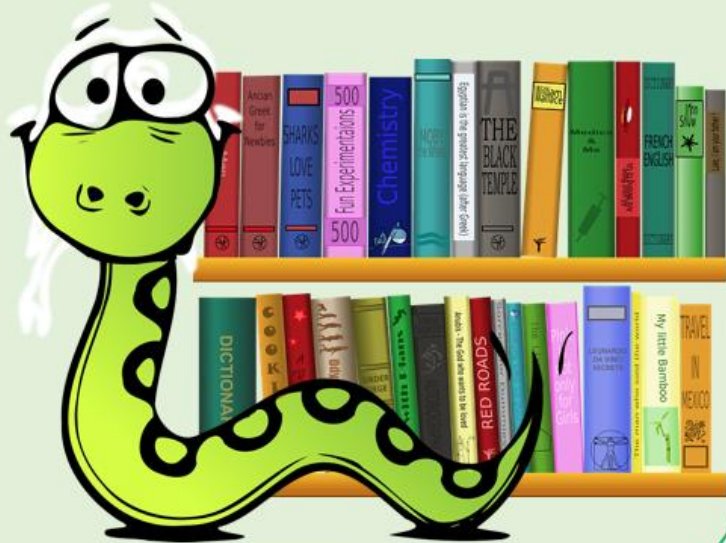
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Predict

Predict (suggest) what might happen from the **details given and implied**.

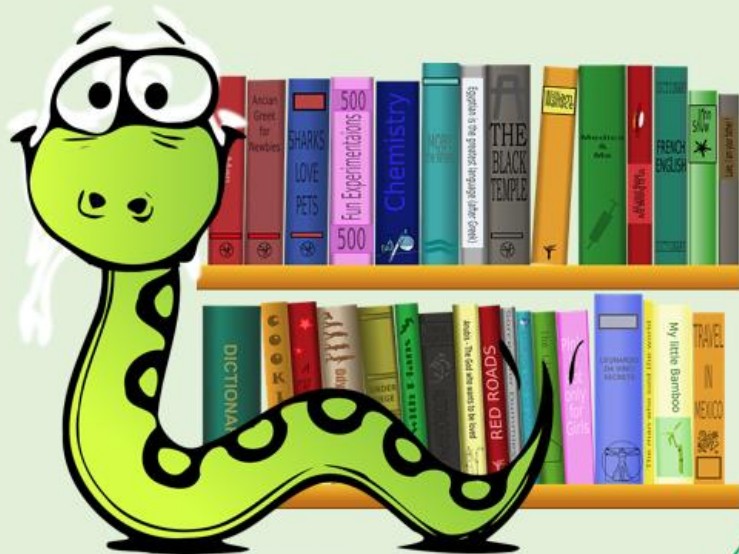

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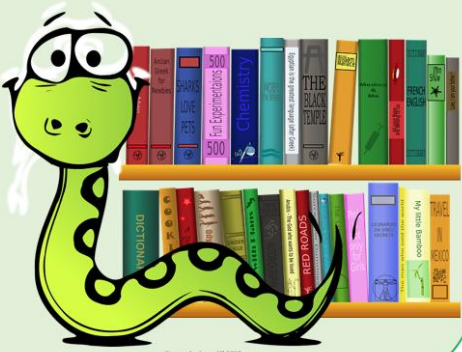

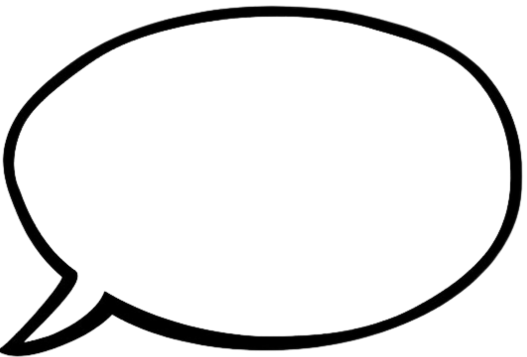

Explain

- Explain how things are **related** and adds to the **meaning** as a whole
- Explain how meaning is **enhanced** through **choice of language**.
- Explain the **themes** and **patterns** that develop across the text.
- Explain how information adds to the overall **experience**.

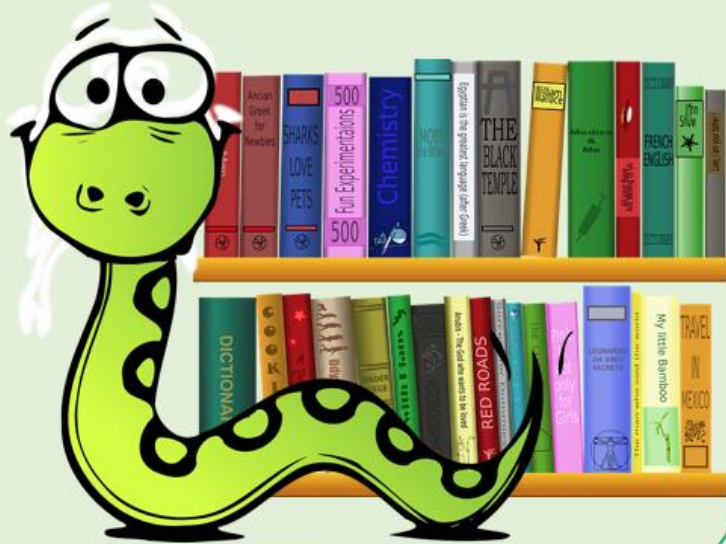

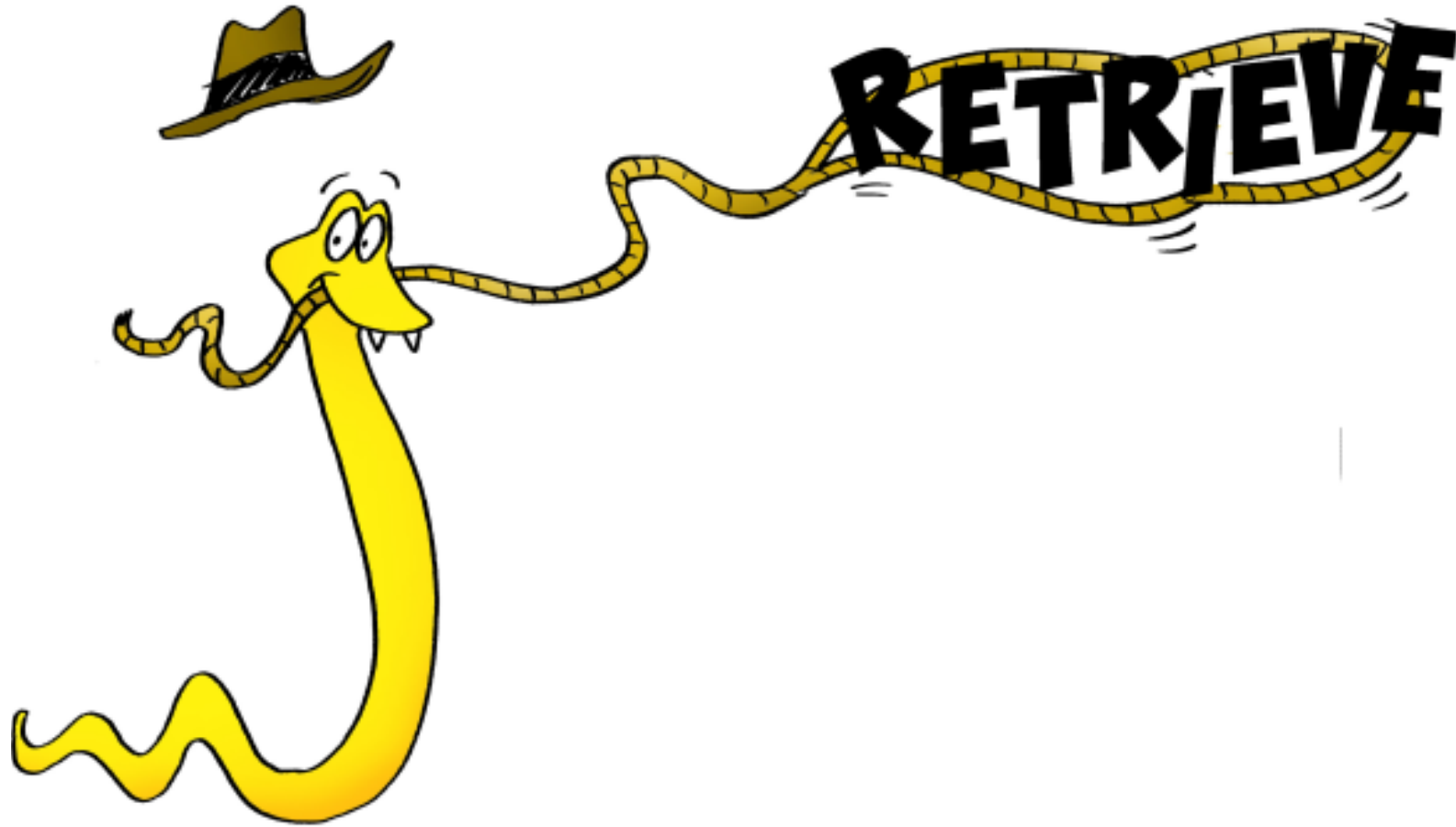

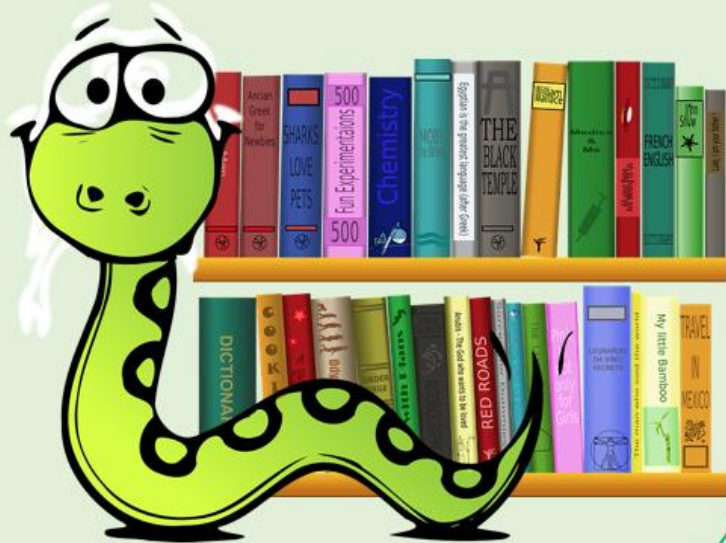
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Retrieve

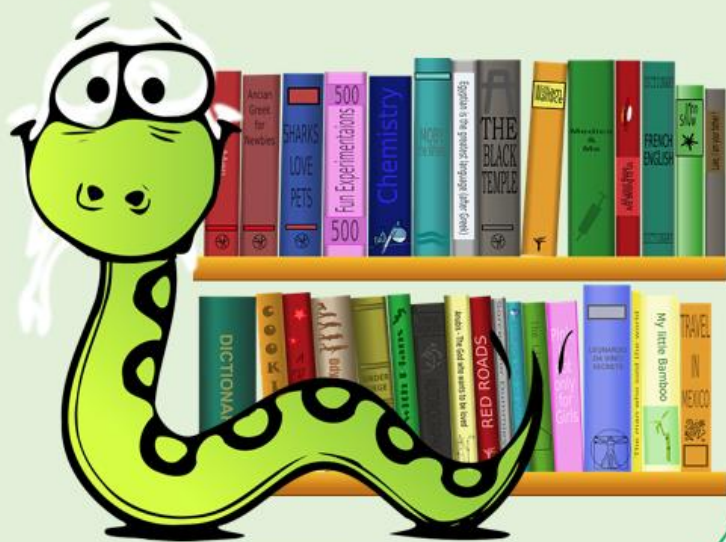
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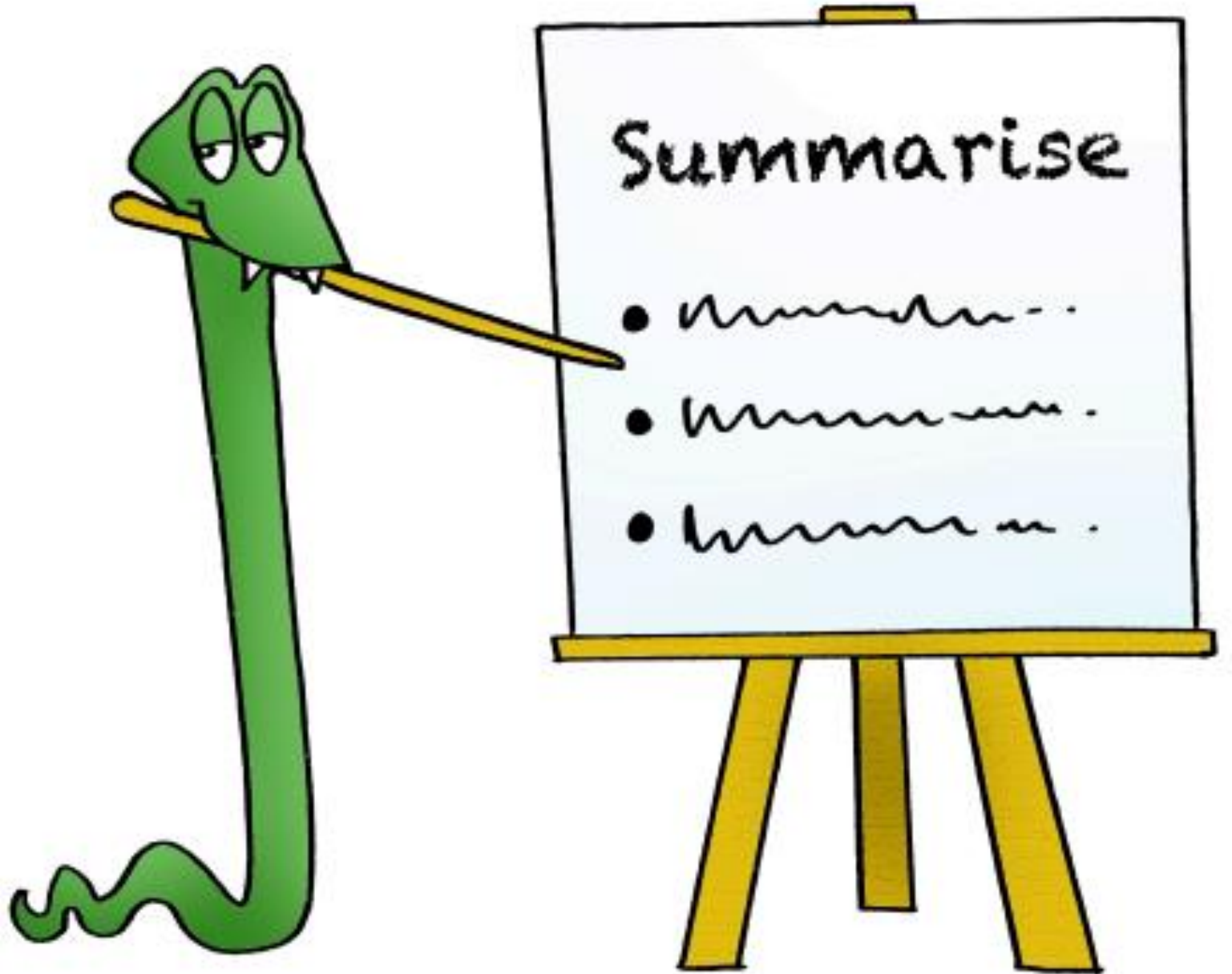

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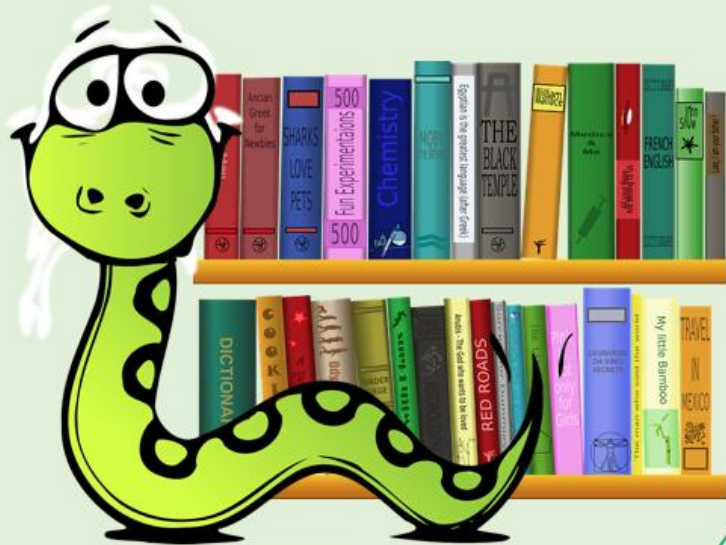


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Summarise
