Terms and Conditions of Parking Permit Link Road Car Parks, Great Missenden

1. Permits can be applied for by parents/carers of pupils who currently attend Great Missenden C of E Combined School.
2. Parents/carers ('Applicants') may apply for more than one permit where more than one car is used to transport a child/ children to/from school e.g. more than one parent, grandparent, childminder (with that person's agreement).
3. Permit holders will only use the permit for the intended purposes, i.e. for dropping off or picking up children at Great Missenden C of E Combined School.
4. The permit is valid for the Link Road Car Park only between the hours of 8.20am and 9.20am for drop off, and between 2.50pm and 3.50pm for pick up, Monday to Friday only.
5. Permits should be clearly displayed throughout the parking period. Failure to display will result in a parking fine being payable.
6. When using the permit, you will abide by all the normal rules of the Link Road Car Parks as given on the Buckinghamshire County Council Car Park Notice Board.
7. There is no guarantee of availability of a parking space.
8. Misuse of the permit will result in the permit becoming invalid and relevant parking fines will then be payable.
9. Permits issued must not be tampered with or they will be invalid.
10. The information recorded in the Permit register may be provided to Buckinghamshire County Council.
